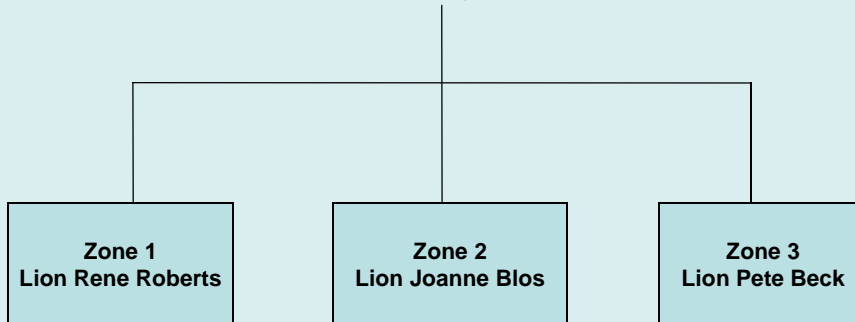
Zone Team Leaders Reporting Structure

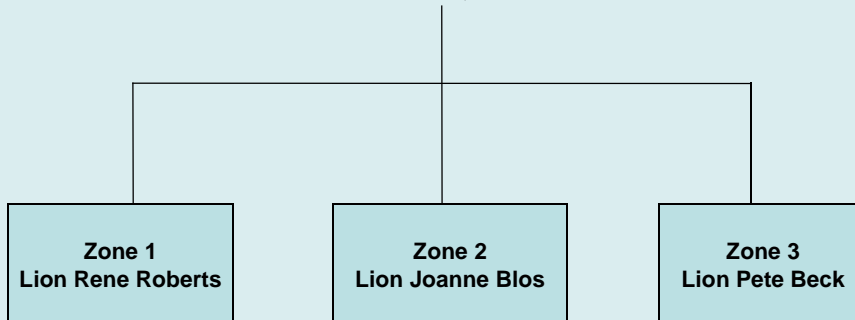
Zone Team Leaders Reporting Structure
